Green Policy

Climate Change continues to be the biggest threat to our planet. At Tramlines HQ we are committed to reducing our impact on the environment and lowering our carbon footprint.

In 2023 we...

- Fueled our generators with Renewable Diesel, a fossil-free alternative to Mineral Diesel which drives Greenhouse Gas emissions down by 90%.
- Used low consumption/hybrid generators where back of house power is required.
- Encouraged crew to share lifts where possible.
- Diverted all waste away from landfill towards recycling or energy production.
- Eliminated all non essential single use plastic at the festival.
- Offered a range of Vegan and Vegetarian food options both front and back of house.

Safety

- Tramlines has a dedicated ambulance provision at the festival, provided by St John's Ambulance, to minimise impacting NHS resources and networks.
- We pay for an event-specific deployment of South Yorkshire Police Officers who work with us to keep the residential streets and perimeters of the festival safe and to prevent anti-social behaviour occurring in Hillsborough.
- We also deploy a high volume of security personnel to help direct attendees on their arrival to and departure from the festival.
- In 2023, we partnered with Strut Safe for the first time, providing a free and confidential support line for solo visitors to access on their journey home from the festival.
- We also continued our partnership with UN Women UK to deliver 'Safe Spaces Now,' an initiative committed to tackling sexual harassment at live events.
