PARK ACCESS

Phase 1 - Monday 14th July

Tramlines Festival build commences.

Large portions of the north section of the park will be inaccessible from this point, including the car park accessed from Parkside Road. To the south, HASA's football pitches will also be closed to the public. The middle section in blue will remain open to residents but with controlled work areas until Phase 2 begins.

Phase 2 - Monday 21st July

Most of Hillsborough Park will be inaccessible until after the event.

The pathway linking Broughton Road to Middlewood Road will be kept open for as long as possible as we appreciate this is an important route for residents. The path will be closed between Wednesday 23rd - Tuesday 29th July inclusive.

Thursday 31st July

The blue section will open to residents again.

Saturday 2nd August

All of Hillsborough Park will be accessible to residents again.

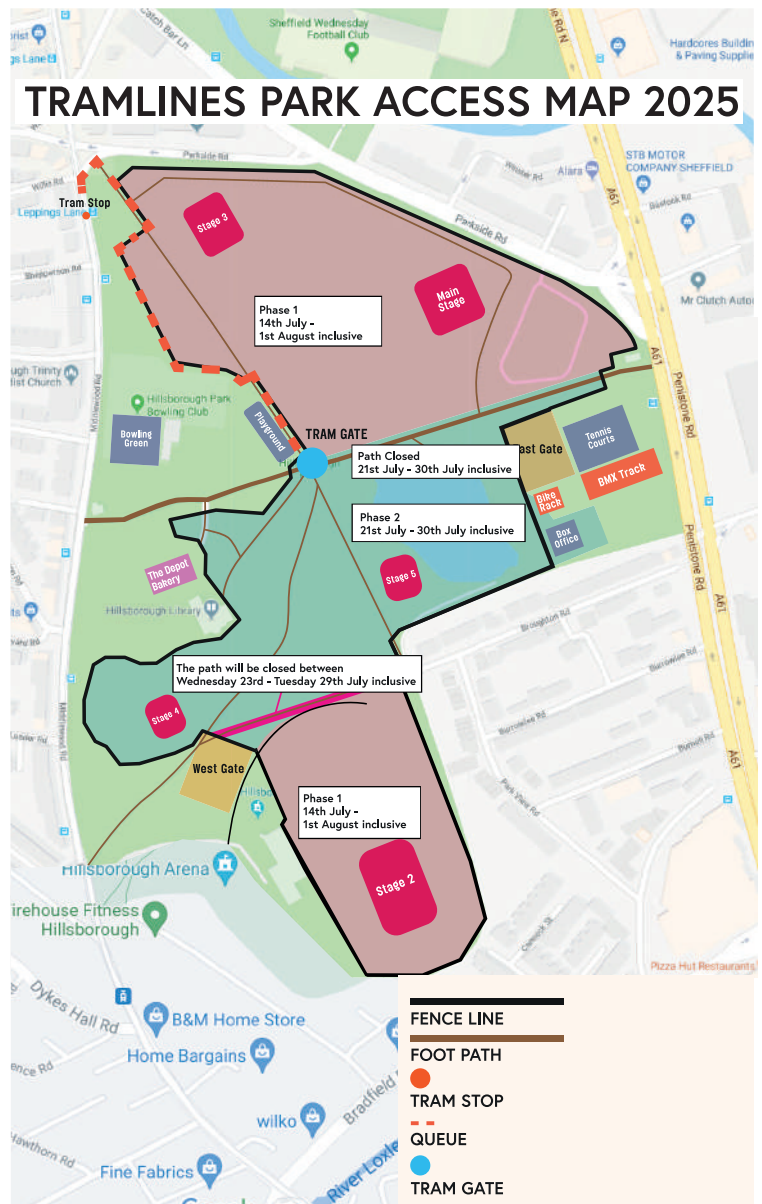

RE-ENTRY

There is no readmission to Tramlines Festival after entry so please plan ahead!

Those with unforeseen or emergency circumstances during the weekend should speak to staff at the Customer Service tent. The Customer Service Team will also make arrangements for parents who need to take children home and wish to return to site on their own later. As always, access customers can organise re-entry with our access team.

Please be aware, those permitted to re-enter the festival will be able to do so once, subject to the same entrance procedures as first arrival and will have to be back on site before the gates close for all ticket holders at 19:30.

NOISE

We are committed to ensuring that noise from Tramlines is controlled to within the limits agreed with the local authority. Our team of external noise consultants, Joynes Nash, have developed a noise management plan aiming to minimise noise nuisance for local residents and monitor noise levels throughout the show weekend.

This enables the festival to measure the noise that is leaving the festival from the stage PA systems to check how sound is behaving in the area.

***Sound checks*
Sound check noise isn't continuous but rather an occasional checking of levels within the time window.

ROAD CLOSURES FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Please see the table below for estimated road closure times for 2025. These road closures are for all traffic, including residents. Due to possible schedule changes at the event, these are only estimates:

Please note in emergency situations, or if it is required, any or all of the roads contained within the TTRO can be closed at any time if it is deemed essential for the safety of attendees, residents or any other persons.

SECURITY

We have been working closely with South Yorkshire Police and the local licensing authority to ensure that we have suitable support during the event. Tramlines will continue to endeavour to limit the impact on the surrounding community.

SANITATION

We will have toilet provision on entry/exit gates and will deploy security to the surrounding area to help deter anti-social behaviour.

Our litter picking team will clean the park and a separate, dedicated team will cover the surrounding streets and departure routes. If any resident calls our Resident Liaison Team with a complaint about litter, this team will be deployed to resolve the issue.

RESIDENT STREET ACCESS

We operate an extensive Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) to further deter attendees from parking on residential streets, lower volumes of traffic and improve public and attendee safety in the area. Please check the map below if your street is included this year.

Access will be maintained for residents, business owners, their employees and customers on these roads.

If your road is highlighted in orange it will be part of our TTRO and you will need to display a Resident Street Access Hanger in your vehicle on event days to gain access to your streets. Please be aware that these hangers are not parking permits and are for access to your roads only.

Each property in this area automatically receives one hanger per household, if there is more than one vehicle registered to your address, please email residents@tramlines.org.uk to request further hangers or come to HASA on 21/7/25 & 22/7/25 between 1pm and 6pm. Please note, you will need to provide proof of address.

If your street isn't highlighted orange but has a red sign at the end of your road, as in previous years, you won't need a hanger but we will have signage and roaming marshals deterring attendees from parking.
